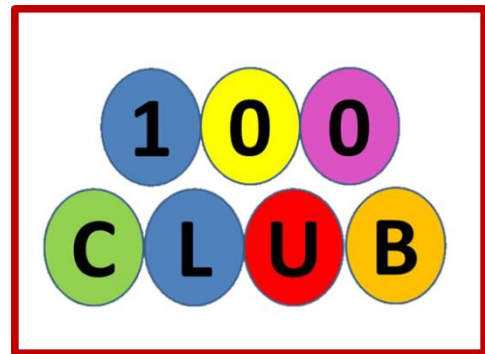


#WORLDBOOKDAY 2018

CLASS 2 TRIP TO BLUE PLANET AQUARIUM

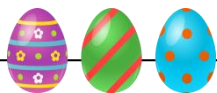
