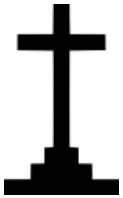

We're looking forward to seeing you all on Friday!



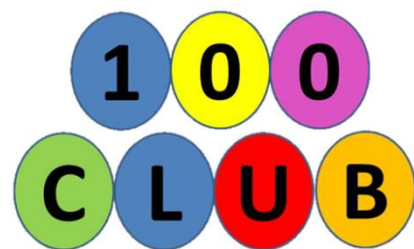
