Do you have any artificial flowers etc at home, if so- we would be very grateful. We will also be working with Olly from Woodlands Learning to make an outdoor reflective area.

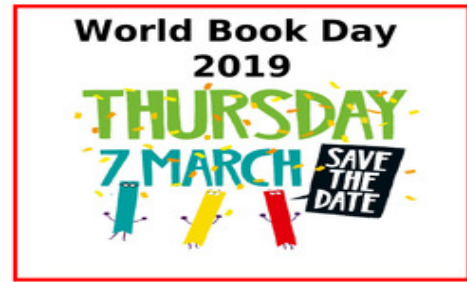
After School Club:

All sessions can be booked for after school club via the scopy.

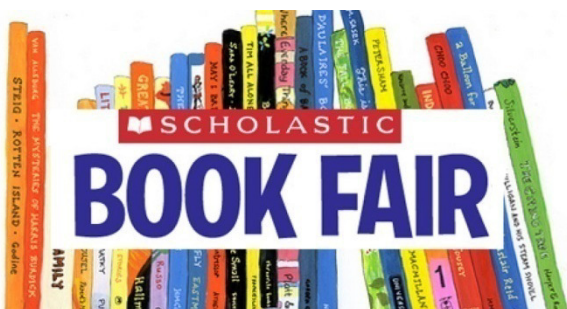
