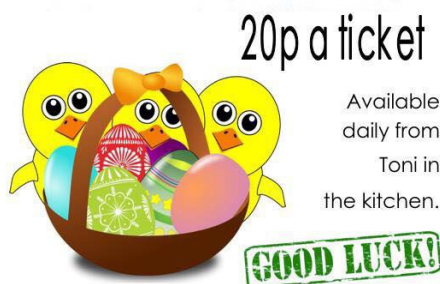

Mothers Day Afternoon Tea will be on Thursday 28th March from 1.30pm.

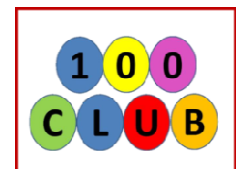

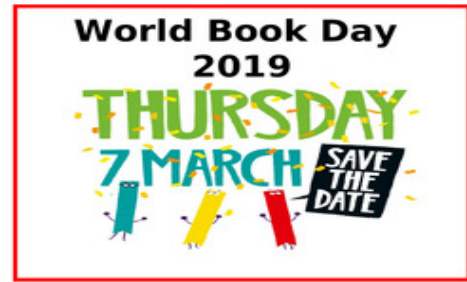
The Jumble Sale made £80 THANK YOU to all the amazing children who helped and also to everyone who supported us.

We will be litter picking at lunchtimes- from 11th -22nd March.

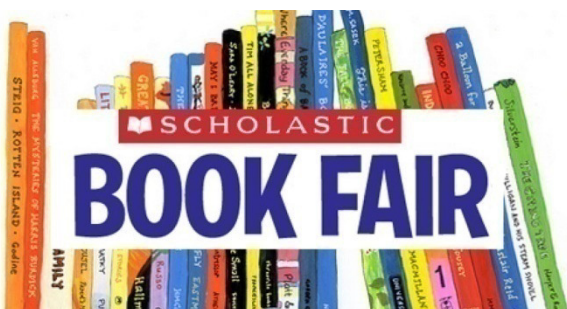
