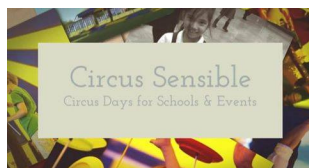
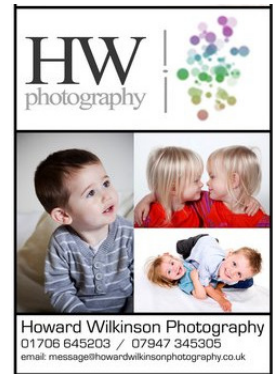

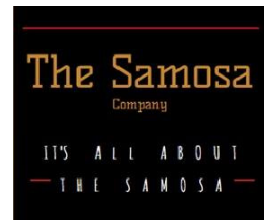

I have received a complaint from one of our neighbours on Moss Side Street concerning inconsiderate parking by parents particularly at drop off/pick up times. Please can I again respectfully remind parents not to cause unnecessary inconvenience to our neighbours when collecting your children from school or visiting school by car. Just to clarify, all of the land beyond the row of terraced houses on Moss Side Street is private land and should not be used for parking/waiting or turning.

We have one space available for persons with reduced mobility who hold a 'blue badge' permit adjacent to the school staff carpark, please keep this space available for people with a genuine need.
