#### **Lateral Flow Testing**

Lateral flow testing for all school staff started this week, which involves staff members taking a home test twice a week.

Obviously, we hope that all results will continue to come back as negative! If any results come back positive, I will have to close the bubble with immediate effect. As staff are taking the tests first thing in the morning (in line with the NHS advice we have received), this closure would only happen at very short notice. Please accept my apologies should this happen. Your child would be able to access the live teaching from home if a positive test for a staff member were to come through. I would then update parents as soon as I possible could about the isolation period. I would like to thank you in advance of any possible disruption.


